Afterschool Program and Youth Summer Camp



Under the Parks & Police 4 Kids Foundation guidelines, the City of Doral Police Department coordinates with the City of Doral Parks and Recreation Department and joins forces with Schools in Doral to help lower the dropout rate of students at risk, by providing input, expertise and activities that will promote positive attitude towards self, school, and community. The targeted students reside in the City of Doral.



For the current school year (2023-2024), the Afterschool Program was held at Renaissance Middle Charter School, and it served 17 students.



The Parks and Police 4 Kids Foundation also partners with the City of Doral Police Department for a Youth Summer Camp. For 2024, the 2 week Summer Camp focused on sport activities, gaming and coding, fishing and police presentations.



Florida International University (FIU) First Generation Scholarship



Florida International University's First Generation Scholarship Program is supported by an innovative matching grant program. Established in 2006 by Florida Legislature, the program provides financial support to qualified undergraduate FIU students who are the first generation in their family to pursue a college degree.

The Parks and Police 4 Kids Foundation provided a gift of \$35,000 to support the established City of Doral First Generation Scholarship Fund. Funding was prioritized to meet the needs of degree-seeking undergraduate students with a permanent address in the city of Doral.
