

RESOLUTION No. 24-215

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER WITH EXP US SERVICES INC. TO PROVIDE DESIGN AND PERMITTING SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE NW 112 AVENUE AND NW 50 STREET INTERSECTION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$95,384.11, WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CONDITIONS, RECOGNIZING THAT EXP US SERVICES INC IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Public Work Department (PWD) needs to secure a firm to provide the design and permitting services for the proposed traffic signal at the NW 112th Avenue and NW 50th Street intersection; and

WHEREAS, the PWD requested a proposal from EXP US Services Inc. (EXP) to perform design and permitting phase the proposed traffic signal at the NW 112th Avenue and NW 50th Street intersection; and

WHEREAS, EXP provided attached proposal with a not to exceed amount of \$95,384.11, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Contract between EXP and the City of Doral was procured through the publicly advertised Request for Qualification (RFQ) 2023-08 process to select a pool of pre-qualified Continuing Professional Services firms for "Roadway improvement" projects; and

WHEREAS, this group of eleven (11) firms was approved by the City Council during the March 2024, Council meeting via Resolution No. 24-54; and

WHEREAS, City staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Councilmembers approve Work Order No. 1 to EXP for design and permitting services of the proposed traffic signal at the NW 112th Avenue and NW 50th Street intersection, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, in an amount not to exceed \$95,384.11; and

WHEREAS, funding for this request is available from transportation Fund “Construction in Progress” Account No. 101.80005.500650.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Work Order No. 1 to EXP for design and permitting services of the proposed traffic signal at the NW 112th Avenue and NW 50th Street intersection, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, in an amount not to exceed \$95,384.11 together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Work Order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Pineyro who moved its adoption.

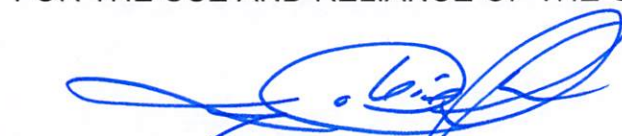

The City of Doral authorizes the firm of EXP US Services, Inc. to provide professional engineering services for the service identified for the project entitled "NW 50th Street and NW 112th Avenue Signalization," located at NW 50th St and NW 112th Avenue. Where EXP US Services, Inc. is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected by Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in March 2024 through Resolution 24-54, the work should be performed by the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between EXP US Services, Inc. and the City of Doral dated February 2, 2024, and the attached Proposal dated July 22, 2024, and submitted by your firm for the above-referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCHEDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from EXP US Services Inc., dated July 22, 2024, to provide the services identified for the project entitled "NW 50th St and NW 112th Avenue Signalization". The schedule requires the scope of work to be completed within Twelve (12) months after the Notice to Proceed is provided. All time limitations set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a lump sum basis not to exceed the amount of \$137,722.03

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work after the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work after the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal and revoke the award.

The Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated January 4, 2021, between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply. The Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and date first above written, in three (3) counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart, be deemed an original Contract.
