## **RESOLUTION No. 25-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE CURRENT TETRA TECH, INC. DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES CONTRACT HOURLY RATES, WHICH WAS AWARDED AS PART OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #2021-14 FOR SERVICES PERFORMED DURING EMERGENCIES ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, South Florida has a high exposure to hurricanes and tropical storms that can create a large economic impact; and

WHEREAS, the best way to mitigate these impacts is to have properly trained City of Doral (the "City") staff and adequate resources that can respond to these emergencies in a timely manner; and

**WHEREAS**, one important component of a properly established response plan is the debris monitoring services; and

WHEREAS, for debris monitoring services the City currently has a contract with Tetra Tech, Inc. which was awarded via Resolution No. 21-142 (approved 4-0, 1 Absent/Excused) as part of RFP 2021-14 "Disaster Debris Monitoring Services"; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract was awarded for an initial three (3) years term with an option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, the final one (1) year extension was executed in June of 2025 and is set to expire on June 28, 2026; and

WHEREAS, during the contract extension process Tetra Tech requested the City to consider a 1.96% hourly rate adjustment to account for changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI), see Exhibit "A" – Tetra Tech, Inc. Rate Adjustment Request; and

WHEREAS, it should be noted that Tetra Tech has not requested a CPI adjustment during the whole duration of this contract; and

**WHEREAS**, it should also be noted that these services are only utilized during emergencies, on an as-needed basis; and

**WHEREAS**, staff respectfully request that the Mayor and the City Councilmembers authorize the City Manager to amend the Tetra Tech contract hourly rates to account for changes in the CPI.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Approval.</u> The amended hourly rates for disaster debris monitoring services during emergencies on an as needed basis, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", are hereby approved.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The City Manager is authorized to amend the contract and expend funds on behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

**Section 4. Implementation.** The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
