BRIEF HISTORY:

Shortly after incorporation, Miami-Dade County transferred control over municipal roads to the City of Doral. Since then, the City has maintained and updated its rights-of-way to ensure a efficient and safe transportation network for all persons that traverse its streets. While the current code provides for the temporary closure of streets, it does not provide for permanent closure. From time to time, the City, individuals, or other government entities may desire to close local roads. Accordingly, it is advisable that the City adopt a process by which the vacation of municipal streets may occur.
