BRIEF HISTORY:

Introduction

The Police Department is seeking approval from the Mayor and Councilmembers for the waiver of competitive bidding for purchases from Florida Bullet, Inc.

Background

The Doral Police Department (DPD) has been purchasing ammunition for the Department's duty ammunition as well as for firearms annual training. Various local agencies such as Miami-Dade Sheriff's Office, Medley Police Department, Hialeah Police Department just to name a few, have conducted testing utilizing FBI ammunition protocol. The last time these tests were conducted by the Miami-Dade Sheriff's Office and each time, Speer Gold Dot ammunition has proven to be a superior round in comparison to other reputable brands. The round maintains its integrity better than the rest and retains more of its weight after testing.

Florida Bullet, Inc. is the only Law Enforcement Distributor authorized for drop shipments directly from the factory within the State of Florida. Florida Bullet has been assisting the needs of government, military, law enforcement and corporate organizations since 1983.
