BRIEF HISTORY:

In 2004, pursuant to Resolution 04-31, the City Council authorized the City's joint participation with Miami-Dade County in the development of the County's Multi-Hazard Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS), as described in the State of Florida Department of Community Affairs publication "The Local Mitigation Strategy: Guidebook for Florida Cities and Counties."

Miami-Dade County (the "County"), with input from participating municipalities in the County has prepared a Multi-Hazard Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS), dated July 2025, that will act as the City's Floodplain management Plan, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
