ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACTUAL EXTENSION FOR THE CONTINUED USE OF TYLER TECHNOLOGIES INC'S ENERGOV PERMITTING AND LAND MANAGEMENT SUITE (EPL), ENERGOV LICENSING AND REGULATORY MANAGEMENT SUITE, IG WORKFORCE SUITE, ENERGOV CITIZEN SELF-SERVICE (CSS), ENERGOV EREVIEWS, PAYMENT PROCESSING, ENERGOV GIS, ENERGOV IVR, AND ENERGOV ODATA AND REST APIs (INTEGRATION TECHNOLOGIES), INCLUDING ANNUAL MAINTENANCE AND ASSOCIATED APPLICATION EXTENSIONS, PLUG-INS, AND FUTURE MAINTENANCE, AND AN INITIAL HOSTED SOLUTION MAINTENANCE PERIOD FROM THE PROVIDER, FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR (4) YEARS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED BUDGETED FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

The City's Development Services Departments including Planning/Zoning, Building, Public Works and Code Compliance implemented the Tyler Suite of products in March 2021 under Res.
