Introduction

Eduardo Orozco (the "Applicant") is requesting approval of a Special Event Permit from the Mayor and the City Council to host Miami Inline Marathon Event, pursuant to Chapter 35 of the City Code of Ordinances ("City Code"). The proposed event will be hosted at the area detailed in the Road Closure section of this staff report on Sunday, October 12, 2025, from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. A copy of the application is provided in "Exhibit A".

Background

The goal of this event is to promote active lifestyles and foster community engagement by encouraging participation from Doral residents and local businesses in a healthy, vibrant, and inclusive setting. Open to all age groups, the RUN DORAL 2025 event will feature a 5K race designed to appeal to the City's diverse demographic, offering families and individuals a fun and accessible wellness experience.

The event will also include recorded music and a selection of food trucks to enhance the atmosphere and provide amenities for participants and spectators. The applicant anticipates approximately 400 attendees throughout the duration of the event. In accordance with Chapter

35 of the City Code of Ordinances, any event expecting 400 or more attendees requires approval by the City Council.

5. Attendance Estimate

- The Applicant estimates approximately 400 attendees during the entirety of the event. *Pursuant to City Code Section 35-20(d) events that expect four (400) hundred attendees or more require the approval of the City Council.
