

RESOLUTION No. 24-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING ISSUING A CALL TO ARTISTS TO BEGIN THE PROCESS OF SELECTING ARTISTS FOR THE CREATION AND INSTALLATION OF ART ON THE DORAL CENTRAL PARK WATER TANK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.00; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, June 15, 2015, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2015-09, Mayor and Councilmembers established the City's Public Art Program to stimulate a cultural environment that reflects and enhances the City's heritage, diversity and character through public artwork integrated in architecture, infrastructure and public places; and

WHEREAS, since the creation of the Public Arts Program, the City established the "Public Arts Program Fund" which is used for the acquisition, installation, improvement, maintenance and insurance of artwork, amongst other art related activities. This account is currently managed by the Parks & Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, Doral Central Park will serve as the largest park within the City's park system and the water tank provides a unique opportunity to provide creative artwork to serve as a notable entrance feature and showcase elements that make up Doral's community; and

WHEREAS, staff respectfully requests Mayor and City Councilmembers approve issuing the call to artist to begin the process of selecting artists for the creation and installation of art on the Doral Central Park water tank in an amount not to exceed \$60,000. Funding is available in the public art fund account 110.90005.500652 (capital outlay-other).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. staff respectfully requests Mayor and City Councilmembers approve issuing the call to artist to begin the process of selecting artists for the creation and installation of art on the Doral Central Park water tank in an amount not to exceed \$60,000. Funding is available in the public art fund account 110.90005.500652 (capital outlay-other)..

The agreement is subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency and on such other terms and conditions as may be appropriate to protect and further the interest of the City. This authorization does not create or confer any rights to Carrier or any of the other firms.

Section 3. Authorization. The Mayor and City Councilmembers approve issuing the call to artist to begin the process of selecting artists for the creation and installation of art on the Doral Central Park water tank in an amount not to exceed \$60,000. Funding is available in the public art fund account 110.90005.500652 (capital outlay-other).

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
