A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO UTILIZE THE GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION CONTRACT No. GS-07F-0031W NEGOTIATED WITH MILLENIUM PRODUCT INC. IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$1,000,000.00) FOR THE PURCHASE OF LICENSE PLATE READERS (LPR) AND EQUIPMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM THE ACCOUNT No. 001.60005.500647; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

The Police Department is seeking approval from the Mayor and City Councilmembers for the utilization of the General Services Administration Contract No. GS-07F-0031W for the purchase of License Plate Readers and equipment to be purchased from Millenium Products Inc. The City is seeking a waiver of competitive bidding.

The Police Department was awarded \$1,000,000.00 from the Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services FY2023 COPS Technology Program for the **Doral Police Department (DPD) Real-Time Operations Center (RTOC) Safe-City Policing Technology Project** per Resolution No. 23-155. The RTOC provides the DPD the ability to capitalize on a wide and expanding range of technologies for more efficient and effective policing. The DPD RTOC is the nucleus of various resources that are necessary to ensure the safety of our community. The DPDs RTOC utilizes current and evolving technologies to assist in the coordination of sworn and non-sworn police resources. The DPD is embracing the concept of a 'Safe City' through efforts and initiatives that provide security, keep our citizens safe from a range of risks, including emergencies, natural disasters, and crime, while helping to smooth operations and positively impact quality of life in our city.

The City of Doral currently has 147 LPRs which provide real time tag information for all vehicles entering and leaving the City. This information is received by the RTOC and instantly distributed to on-duty police resources. DPD receives over 12 million monthly plate detections which results in 3% of "Hits" in categories for Stolen Vehicles, Missing Persons, Missing Persons Disability, Amber Alerts, Child Abductors, Felony Vehicles, Fugitives,

Homicides, Law Enforcement Suspects, and Officer Safety Persons of Interest, Sex Offenders, Terrorists and Wanted Vehicles. In addition, the LPR's provide business intelligence analytics that provide insight into the count of vehicles that enter the City by intersection, time of day, day of week, daily, weekly or monthly. At this time, the DPD is in need of completing the installation of LPRs in the entry and exit intersections throughout the City of Doral to enhance our security portfolio which provides the tools to capture accurate license plate recognition data, but more importantly, empowers public safety to use those detections to increase officer awareness, patrol productivity and investigative efficiency.

This project allows the DPD RTOC to access innovative technologies available to enhance the way the DPD predicts, prevents, and responds to crime within the City of Doral. The Safe-City strategies bring together solutions that help improve emergency preparedness, provide first responders and law enforcement with greater situational awareness with smart alerts, face recognition, AI computer vision and technology that enables investigators to view hours of real time security video in just minutes. These digitally connected solutions can come together to organize and optimize resources and ultimately protect lives.
