A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ADOPT-A-STREET LITTER REMOVAL AGREEMENT WITH “ALBIZU CLINIC – GOODMAN PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES CENTER”, FOR THE PROVISION OF LITTER REMOVAL ACTIVITIES ALONG NW 33 STREET BETWEEN NW 97 AVENUE AND 107 AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

As part of the City of Doral “Keep Doral Beautiful” campaign, the Public Works Department (PWD) established the “Adopt-a-Street” program in 2005. It provides the opportunity for volunteer groups to clean and remove litter from the City’s public right-of-way at least four (4) times a year for a period of two (2) years. The Program provides the option to automatically renew the agreement if the applicant adheres to the Program requirements. The total weight amount of garbage collected by the volunteers is reported on a yearly basis to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) as part of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

The Albizu Clinic – Goodman Psychological Services Center submitted an application to participate in this program to help maintain the City streets and Keep Doral Beautiful.

The Albizu Clinic – Goodman Psychological Services Center have been providing services to the community since 1980. It is an outpatient treatment facility for mental health and speech and language services which also provides, in partnership with Albizu University, an in-house training facility for all clinical programs.
