ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A WORK ORDER WITH STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO THE DESIGN AND PERMITTING OF A NEW ROUNDABOUT LOCATED AT NW 112 AVENUE AND NW 82 STREET, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY SIX THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY NINE DOLLARS AND 36/100 (\$76,769.36); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

In August 2025, the Public Works Department (PWD) requested a proposal from Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) to prepare a Traffic Engineering Study for the intersection of NW 112th Avenue and NW 82nd Street as a result of various traffic concerns. Based on the intersection analysis a roundabout was the recommended improvement to mitigate safety concerns and provide operational improvements. The proposed roundabout at the subject intersection was approved by Miami-Dade County's Traffic Engineering Division as a long-term improvement.

In March 2026, the PWD requested a subsequent proposal from Stantec for the design and permitting phase of the new roundabout for the intersection of NW 112th Avenue and NW 82nd Street. Per Miami-Dade County's comments on the initial report, the scope of work will also include a queue analysis to be performed in Synchro to evaluate the interaction between the proposed roundabout and the existing signalized intersection at NW 114th Avenue and NW 82nd Street. The PWD negotiated with Stantec the attached proposal in a not to exceed amount of \$76,769.36. The design phase should be completed within 214 calendar days.

The contract between Stantec and the City of Doral was procured through the publicly advertised Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 2023-08 process, which was used to select a pool of pre-qualified Engineering and Architecture firms. This group of eleven (11) firms was

approved by the City Council during the March 2024 Council meeting, via Resolution No. 24-54 (approved 5-0).

The City remains fully committed to resolve traffic concerns and is actively working on improvements throughout the City. The improvement on this zone is included within the Transportation Master Plan in order to improve vehicular circulation and safety.
