

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND THE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH BEEFREE, LLC. D/B/A FREEBEE THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2026 TO COINCIDE WITH THE FDOT GRANT PERIOD, TO PROVIDE FIRST AND LAST MILE DOOR-TO-DOOR ON-DEMAND TRANSIT SERVICE FOR CITY'S SENIOR CITIZENS UNDER THE CURRENT TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND PRICING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE DEPARTMENTAL BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT AND TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY WITH RESPECT TO THE AGREEMENT APPROVED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral's (the "City") Public Works Department (PWD) continuously explores ways to provide alternative modes of transportation options to its residents, employees, and visitors as a mean to improve mobility and reduce congestion, and

WHEREAS, on the August 2023, Council Meeting, the Mayor and Councilmembers expressed interest in providing an on-demand transit service to the City's senior citizen population; and

WHEREAS; at the December 2023, Council Meeting, the PWD presented to the Mayor and Councilmembers a high level overview of vendors that currently provide on-demand transit services in South Florida; and

WHEREAS, at the March 13, 2024, Council Meeting, the Mayor and City Councilmembers adopted Resolution No. 24-53 (approved 5-0) authorizing the City Manager to waive the competitive bidding process and approve a contract with Freebee

for the establishment of a six (6) month pilot program to provide first-last mile door-to-door on-demand transit service to seniors for up to 50 hours a week; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2024, the City launched the City's Senior On-Demand Transit Service; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2024, the PWD coordinated with Freebee and the City Manager's office to increase operating hours and include a weekend service for up to 50 hours a week which has been requested by most seniors; and

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2024, the Mayor and City Councilmembers adopted Resolution No. 24-220 authorizing a contract extension with Freebee for a one (1) year period; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2024, the City was notified of the awarded Public Transit Service Development Program Grant for the City's On-Demand Transit Service for the Fiscal Year 2026 to provide an additional vehicle to the city service and improve waiting times; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2025, the Mayor and City Councilmembers adopted Resolution No. 25-110 authorizing a contract extension with Freebee for the Senior service to coincide with the FDOT grant period; and

WHEREAS, at September 15, 2025, Council Meeting, the Mayor and Councilmembers adopted Resolution 25-227 authorizing the City to enter into a Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the City of Doral On-Demand Transit service within City limits; and

WHEREAS, the PWD entered into the Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the FDOT on October 12, 2025, for a one-year period; and

WHEREAS, after coordination with Freebee, the Freebee Senior service was expanded from two (2) vehicles to three (3) vehicles on Tuesday, November 4, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the current contract with Freebee is set to expire on June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department respectfully request that the Mayor and Councilmember authorize the City Manager to extend the Senior Service Program with Freebee through November 30, 2026, to coincide with the FDOT Grant period to provide last-mile door-to-door on-demand transit service at an amount not to exceed the Departmental budgeted funds while the City works on research, development and procure an advertising of a new Request for Proposals (RFP) for an On-Demand Transit Service; and

WHEREAS, funding to cover the cost for this request is budgeted in Fiscal Year 2025-26, in the Transportation Plan Fund – “Contractual Services” Account, Account Num. 101.80005.500341.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The Service Contract Agreement extension through November 30, 2026, between the City of Doral and Freebee for door-to-door on-

demand transit service under the same terms and conditions, in an amount not to exceed the departmental budgeted funds, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Service Contract Agreement extension and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
