

**ORDINANCE No. 2026-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 26, ARTICLE V OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO NOISE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Doral ("City") has codified its regulation of events which may produce noise; and

**WHEREAS**, in the 2025, the City inaugurated a world class amphitheater at its Central Park with the vision of attracting world renown outdoor performances; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 4, 2025, the City Mayor and Council passed Resolution 25-140, which authorized the execution of an agreement for the management of the Central Park Amphitheater at Central Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the changes to the City's Noise Ordinance will allow for greater flexibility in the programing of events at Central Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the changes contained in this Ordinance are in the City's best interest.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

**Section 2. Amending Chapter 26, Article V., Noise.**

**Sec. 26-129. Open-air concerts, musical broadcasts, etc.**

Open air concerts, musical broadcasts, and all other open-air events held at the City's Central Park shall not be governed by this chapter. All open events held at the City's  
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Central Park shall be governed by separate agreement between the City and, or its agent, and the event producer. All other The requirements and for a permit and regulations, including the permit process of open-air concerts, musical broadcasts, etc., shall be as provided in chapter 35, article II.

**Section 3. Conflicts.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same, are hereby repealed.

**Section 4. Severability.** If any section, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected by such invalidity.

**Section 5. Incorporation into the Code.** It is the intention of the Mayor and the City Council, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Doral, and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intentions.

**Section 6. Effective Date** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by the City Council on second reading.
